Last December, all we heard was Osama this, Osama that. Three weeks have gone by without a peep from anyone on bin Laden.

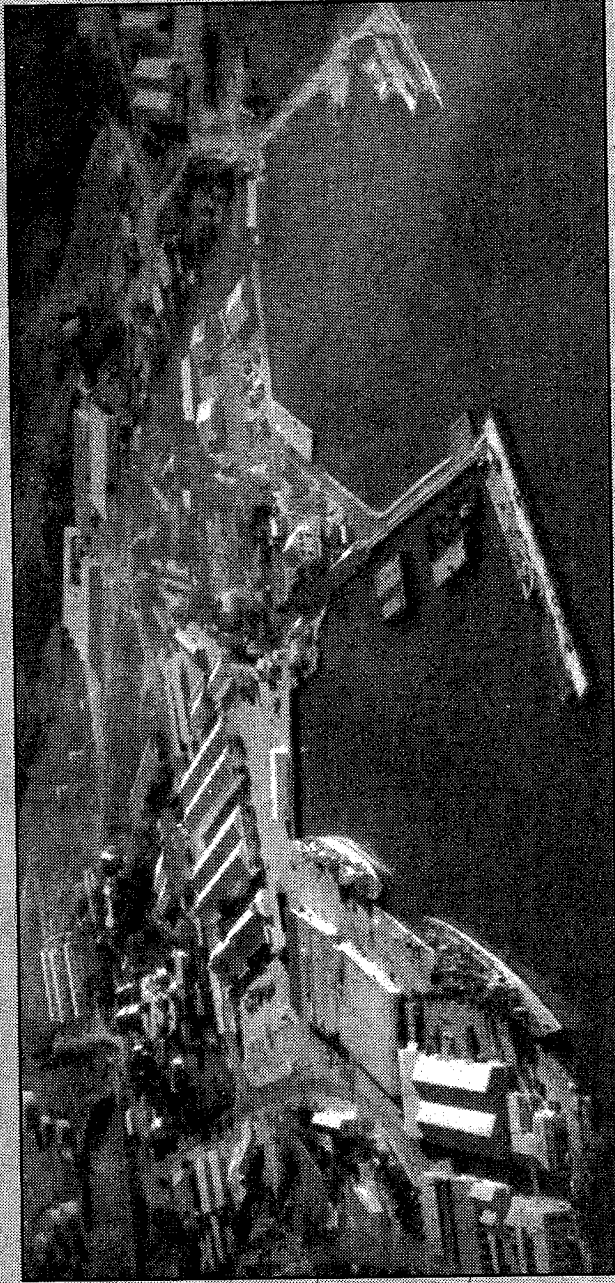
He's vanished from sight and from mind and this with a \$50 million bounty on his head! Where did all the venture capitalists in the world go?
